It is important to keep the above information in mind when choosing to provide treats for birthday and other celebrations.

Reminders

- ❖ Please label your children's clothing (e.g. snow pants, jackets, boots, etc.). This will help both children and staff to quickly and easily identify items.
- ❖ Please ensure that your child has a separate pair of indoor shoes at the daycare. Running shoes are the most appropriate as they are required for participating in gym activities.
- ❖ Boots that are warm and waterproof are ideal for outdoor play.
- ❖ Remove drawstrings from clothing as they could catch on play equipment and become a choking hazard.
- ❖ Neck warmers (instead of scarves) and mitten clips (instead of a string) are safer alternatives.
- ❖ Having your child wear a hat is a good idea as a lot of body heat is lost through the head.
- ❖ Please be sure to make eye contact with a teacher when picking up and dropping off your child.
