#### SCHOOL AGE ROOMS

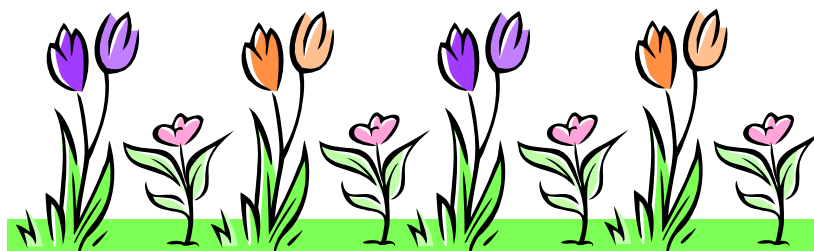
##### *Rooms 105 & 106*

### *Nursery School and Preschool Graduation*

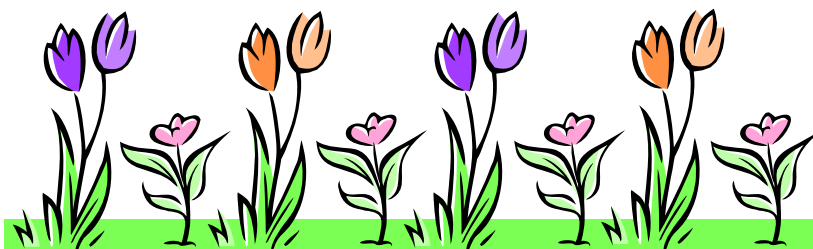

## CHRISTINE CUSHING'S ORANGE CREAMSICLES

These are definitely a taste of summer to enjoy all year round!

### INGREDIENTS:

- 1 cup orange juice concentrate, slightly softened so easy to scoop (250 ml)
- 1 cup yogurt (250 ml)
- 1 cup softened vanilla ice cream (250 ml)
- 2 tbsp light corn syrup (30 ml)

### DIRECTIONS:

1. Place orange juice, yogurt, vanilla ice cream and corn syrup into a food processor or blender. Pulse until combined. Pour evenly into popsicle moulds. Lightly knock the moulds to release air bubbles. Insert popsicle sticks. Freeze until solid, about 8 hours to overnight. Serve. Makes about 2  $\frac{1}{2}$  cups of base that fills seven  $\frac{1}{3}$  cup moulds.
